- We adhere to all Portsmouth City Council procedures concerning health and safety, Criminal Records Bureau checks and first aid.
If your child is successfully accepted onto a course but cannot attend then please advise the PS office. Do not offer this place to a friend or sibling. Please call us as there is often a waiting list for courses and we can then offer this place to another child.
Please note that we do not operate on a first come-first served basis and that applying for our courses does not automatically guarantee a place on your first choice course.
Your voluntary donation helps support the real cost of your child's course place (approximately £38 per course).
The information about your child's participation in Pompey Stars will be passed on to schools, Portsmouth City Council and other agencies e.g. Community Improvement Partnerships. This is to monitor the Extended Services Programme within Portsmouth, to ensure that all children have access to a variety of extended services in or through their school. We may also contact you from time to time via your child's school with important information about Pompey Stars. If you do not wish your child's details to be passed on or you do not wish to be contacted by us please inform us in writing.

How to Apply

- 1. Each course is run over two Saturdays. Your child can choose any course from any school.
2. Fill in your child's choice(s) on the application form. Please put a second choice in case their first choice is full. You can only apply by completing this form. Please note that your child will not be allowed to join any activities without this.
3. If you decide to make a voluntary donation please put the money or cheque in a sealed envelope with your child's name and school written on the front, and attach this to the application form. Please write your child's name on the back of the cheque (made payable to Portsmouth City Council.) Also, please attach an envelope with a stamp on it and your own address so that we can send your acceptance slip back. You will be informed as to whether or not you have received a place.
4. 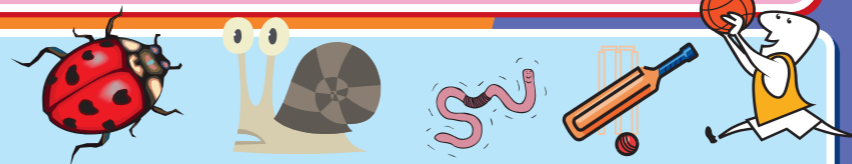
